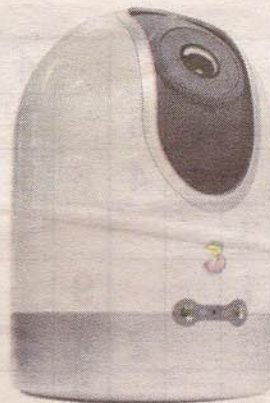
1 Fellowes DS-1 shredder £80

Thanks to its cross-cut shredding pattern, which is more secure than ribbon-cut, this can handle 12 sheets at a time, destroy credit cards and isn't put off by staples or paper-clips. www.fellowes.co.uk; 01302 836 836



2 Rimax wireless luggage alarm £9.99

Attach the transmitter to your luggage and put the receiver on your key ring and, when the two are more than a certain distance apart, an audible alarm activates. www.rmxdirect.co.uk; 020-7870 7179



3 Pupillo mobile video camera £149.99

This torch is very bright (it has four LEDs) and includes an optical smoke detector. If it "sees" any it emits a piercing noise and switches on. www.flarebrands.com



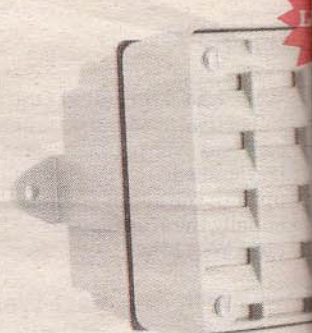
7 Rimax Security Phone £139.99
